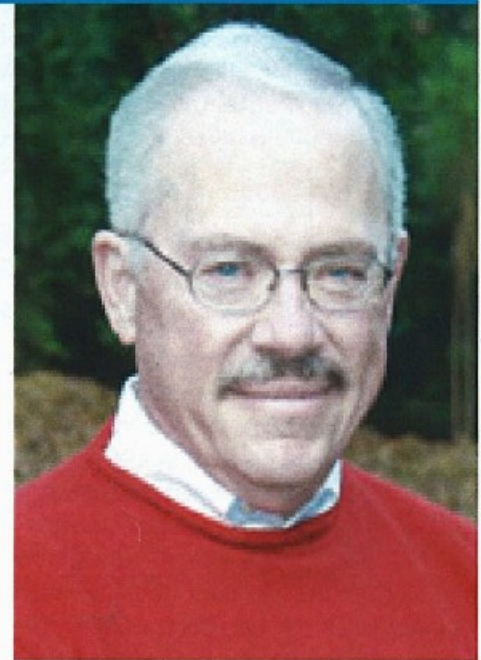

Michael Battle, Executive Director EOUSA (U.S. Attorney W.D. of NY 2001-2005). Graduated State University of New York at Buffalo Law School 1981; Assistant U.S. Attorney 1985-92 to our friend Judge Salvatore Martoche (WD NY 1982-86), helped establish the Federal Public Defenders Office in Rochester, NY; Assistant New York's State Attorney General in charge of Buffalo Office. Appointed by Governor Pataki as Judge on the Erie County Family Court Bench and subsequently elected to that Judgeship for 10 years. Has been a member of the Attorney General's Advisory Committee. Appointed Executive Director of the Executive Office of U.S. Attorneys, May 2005.



James Brosnahan, A Senior partner with Morrison & Foerster in California. Received his B.S.B.A. degree in 1956 from Boston College and his LL.B in 1959 from Harvard Law School, was an Assistant U.S. Attorney in Phoenix, AZ for five years. His expertise is in civil and criminal trial work. In 1992, he was a member of the Office of the Independent Counsel which prosecuted Casper Weinberger in the Iran-Contra Case. The National Law Journal named him as one of the country's 10 best trial lawyers and one of the most influential.

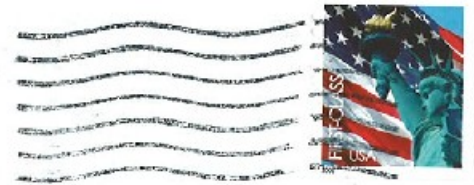
